



E ARLY YEARS PUPIL PREMIUM FORM

From April 2015, some children aged three or four may be eligible to benefit from the Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP). The premium is worth up to £300 per child per year, and it is paid directly to your child's Early Years setting. This is for the purpose of improving the quality of early education for your child and ensuring that they are given the best start towards educational achievement.

In order to identify those children who may benefit, the Local Authority will need to confirm eligibility by carrying out a simple check. Families who meet the criteria below are likely to be eligible for the EYPP, which the early years provider will receive to enhance your child's early education experience. Once completed, please return this form to your child's early year's provider. They will then forward the information to the Local Authority so that the eligibility check can be completed. The early years provider will then confirm to you, whether they can claim the EYPP for your child/children. Please complete this form if any of the criteria listed below applies to you or your family.

- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
